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# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2021–2023

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#### ABOUT THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

'Sustainable development is a globally, regionally and locally occurring process of ongoing and structured societal change aimed at securing desirable living conditions for current and future generations. This also means that the environment, human beings and the economy are given equal consideration in decision-making and activities.'

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The aim of the objectives in the Sustainable Development Plan and the measures set to reach those objectives is to reduce negative environmental effects at all levels of the Student Union's operations as well as to promote the realisation of the principles of sustainable development within the Student Union.

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In its Policy Paper, HYY has committed itself to the Sustainable Development Goals stated in the UN's Agenda 2030, and the Student Union's operations or political policies may not conflict with these goals. The principles of sustainable development must be taken into account in all decision-making processes.<sup>2</sup> In addition to this, HYY's Strategy for 2020–2024 states that ecological sustainability sets the boundaries for all HYY's activities. The Strategy also profiles HYY as a believable and well-known actor in the fight against climate change and other environmental problems. Within HYY, social sustainability translates into enabling the humane and ethical actions of individuals and the community both now and in

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the future – HYY must take responsibility for its members and employees as well as the University community.<sup>3</sup>

The purpose of the Sustainable Development Plan is to define the measures and objectives the Student Union takes in its own operations in relation to sustainable development as well as to encourage organisations operating under the Student Union towards more sustainable operation. The plan guides the Student Union in a cross-sectoral manner, outlining principles, boundaries and objectives for its operations.

The plan is supplemented by environmental instructions drafted for the Central Office as well as environmental instructions for organisations created to support and ease the environmental activities of organisations operating under HYY.

The Sustainable Development Plan is not intended to deal with the ways in which the Student Union advocates the realisation of sustainable development at the University and in society, as the Student Union's Policy Paper defines its advocacy goals, including those related to sustainable development. The plan further does not deal with issues related to sustainable development that are covered by the Ownership Strategy, which guides the Student Union's business operations, or the Medium-term Financial Plan, which guides the Student Union's operating finances.

The plan is divided into two sections. The first section deals with the operations of the Central Office and HYY's committees, whereas the second one covers organisations operating under HYY. The plan is in effect for the 2021–2023 three-year term, and it will next be updated in 2023 to meet the Student Union's needs and goals of that time.

The implementation of the Sustainable Development Plan is assessed with a report written every year, and the objectives are assessed on a scale of achieved – partly achieved – not achieved. The main responsibility for the assessment lies with the members of the Board in charge of environmental and climate affairs and development cooperation, along with the main sector. Based on the assessment conducted at the end of the previous year, the sustainable development sector will, at the beginning of each year, cooperate with the main sector to create a plan on how to reach the sustainable development objectives. A mid-year assessment of the realisation of the objectives set at the beginning of the year is conducted in June.
